

HEARING AND VISION SCREENING

Dear Parents:

Per the State of Maryland, “hearing and vision screenings are required in the year that a student enters a school system, enters the first grade, and enters the eighth or ninth grade.” The State also requires that any child whose screening indicates a potential issue must be re-tested the following year.

Proof that your child (age 4 or older) has had a hearing and vision screening is required. Most pediatricians perform these screening tests during the child's routine physical appointment; please request the results from your pediatrician. A form is attached for your convenience, but a printout from your child’s physician is also acceptable.
